TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- If your son or daughter have any life-threatening allergies, you must inform us upon registration as per Sabrina's Law.
- It is each student's responsibility to assure that the prerequisite for the requested course has been achieved. Please submit a transcript at the time of enrolment demonstrating proof of the prerequisite. We require 15 days notice to cancel any enrolments. There is a \$100 Administration Fee for cancelations.
- Any plagiarized work will receive a mark of zero and the student may be removed from the course.
- Late arrivals disrupt the lesson. Students who arrive late may be refused admittance and time missed will be counted in the overall absence accumulation.
- We reserve the right to cancel courses at any time for insufficient enrolment. In the event a course is cancelled, students can transfer to another course or receive a full refund including the Registration Fee.

EVALUATION

Our teachers emphasize working with individual students to allow them to learn using their unique way of learning (learning style). Teachers take seriously their responsibility to prepare their students for success by communicating accurately the knowledge, skills and attitudes that students are expected to learn. As prescribed by the Ontario Ministry of education the evidence of student achievement is collected over time from three different sources:

- 1) observations
- 2) conversations
- 3) student projects and exams

Using multiple sources of evidence increases the reliability and validity of the evaluation. There is no guarantee of a high mark. Students must work hard to be assured of a top mark. Students and parents should establish realistic academic goals based on performance.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Our students are expected to contribute to a climate that respects all individuals allowing each the opportunity to grow intellectually, develop self-direction, and make positive contributions to the lives of other.

- TEA EXPECTS STUDENTS TO:
 - attend all classes regularly and punctually
 - co-operate with all school staff and with other students
 - take active steps to learn and respect the rights of others to learn

 - accept responsibility for personal behaviour and academic progress
